



#### PARSHAS SHOFTIM

#### LAW AND ORDER REIGN

- Build basketball courts. Or some kind of courts...
   We're supposed to set up court systems and officers to enforce those laws
- Judges must be very careful not to be corrupt, accept bribery or display favoritism
- If a Jew or a group of Jews strays far from the right path and worships other gods, they may be liable for the death penalty
- 2 or 3 witnesses are required for any capital punishment. Wanna know if cameras are good enough? Check out Nageela Shabbos Season 9, Episode 28
- The Rabbis who are right should not be left, and the Rabbis who are left are all right. The Rabbis who write are probably also right. What I'm tryin to say is follow what the Rabbis say, without veering to the right or the other right
- Although there would be a time when the Jewish nation should appoint a king, that king is still subject to certain rules. He shouldn't have too many horses, too many wives, he must keep a Torah scroll with him, and he must be Jewish
- There's a disagreement whether he carried a full (but small) Torah, just one that contained the Ten Statements (which have 613 words, apparently) or a summary of the commandments
- The tribe of Levi would not get any farmland in Israel.
   The Jewish people would need to support the tribe with gifts so they could be the spiritual guides
- Jews love a profit. And a prophet. But not a false one. If somepone claims to be a prophet but their predictions don't come true, don't listen to them

being Jewish?

- You know how when you play tag, there's a base where you're safe? Cities were set up as a kind of base if anyone killed accidentally. While in these cities, relatives of the victim could not take revenge. Roads and good signage were also set up to make sure it was easy to reach these locations. There was even a separate 'accidental killer' setting on Waze
- Instructions are given on how to mustard... That means to gather an army to fight. [what? Did I get the wrong word? Well that's embarrassing]. Instructions are given on how to custard a Jewish army to fight [WHAAAT?]. When a Jewish army goes to war, they first dismiss any soldiers who have reasons to be home (like they just got married, or just got a new XBOX that they haven't used yet) or who might be afraid
- When Jews go to war, we offer peace first, before we offer pieces
- In one of the more unusual commandments in the Torah, we're given instructions on what to do if someone is found dead in between two cities, and it isn't clear who is responsible. It involves a cow, an axe, and some elders. I won't go into details

I've always heard that Abraham is considered the first Jew. If that's the case, why isn't Ishmael Jewish? What about Esau? If Abraham was Jewish, then shouldn't Arabs and Romans be Jewish, too?



Dear OG,

. . . . . . . . . .

I've often had the same question. Let me add one layer of complication. Aside from your question about Esau and Ishmael, there are Talmudic sources that discuss Mount Sinai (400 years after the birth of Isaac) as the moment we became a nation. So when did it really happen, who are the first Jews and what happened to everyone else?

You may notice that we are called the Children of Israel, another name for Jacob, rather than 'Children of Abraham.' Let's break it down. Years ago, there was a movie called Twins, where Arnold Schwarzenegger and Danni Devito were the results of a scientific experiment. One baby (who turned out to be the incredibly fit, intelligent and well-mannered char-



every good gene and trait. The unintended side effect was a second child (who turned out to be the slimy, unfit, uneducated and generally unsavory character played by Danny) who had every negative gene and trait.

The great Jewish thinkers talk about our first families in a similar way. Abraham had a massively holy spark inside him, yet there were still imperfections (genetic fallout from Adam and Eve, Terach and others) inside him that had to be bred out. When he had his sons, the spiritual greatness was absorbed by Isaac (as the one who came from Sarah as well as Abraham) and the Devito-style impurities went to Ishmael and the others. Isaac started with a great deal of purity, but there was still a perfection process that had to be completed. The imperfections there went to Esau and the holiness to Jacob. Only Jacob, born with this heightened level of perfection was able to be the true spiritual father of the Jewish people. If that was a little too mystical for you, here's a simpler way of looking at it: Judaism at the time of Abraham was a startup. It was a great product, but there were no binding contracts. There was a process

of buying into the company, little by little. Abraham founded the company, but in order for a child of Abraham or Isaac to be considered a part of the team, they had to opt in. Isaac opted in and Jacob opted in, while Ishmael, Esau and co. went their own merry way. Jacob was the first genuine CEO, and all his children automatically were born into the company. Even then, it wasn't completely done. At Mount Sinai, we actually entered into a contractual agreement with God, got it notarized, and filed in triplicate.

Either way, know that you are part of a long, beautiful chain of people choosing God over the distractions of the world. If you choose that as well, then you, too, are an OG.

The Midrash says that three more refuge cities will be established when we return to Israel in the Messianic


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Considering that Moshiach time will be one of great peace, knowledge and goodness, when nobody will commit crimes, why will it be necessary to have these cities?
